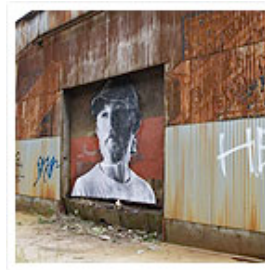
And you? Well, with a little legwork, you'll see the city through new eyes.
